

UNIVERSITY PATHWAYS AND ARTICULATIONS COMMITTEE (UPAC)

Purpose:

Assist in the review and creation of pathways and articulation agreements with other institutions of higher education

Charge:

- Assist in the creation and development of articulation agreements and pathways
- Assist in the collaboration and public relations with community colleges
- Ensure consistency in document creation
- Ensure appropriate signatures are secured
- Ensure that annual or bi-annual reviews occur
- Track all formal agreements for the University

Membership Guidelines:

- Director of Learning PLUS
- Assistant Director of Admissions
- Coordinator of Pathways and School-Based Scholars
- This Committee is overseen by the Vice Provost for Undergraduate Academic Affairs

Membership Appointment:

Vice Provost for Undergraduate Academic Affairs

Membership Terms:

Until appointment is ended by the Vice Provost for Undergraduate Academic Affairs

Frequency of Meetings: Bi-weekly or as needed

Expected Lifespan: Ongoing

Reporting Requirements:

- Reports to the Vice Provost for Undergraduate Academic Affairs monthly.
- Also, as needed, reports to the Vice President for Enrollment & Degree Management, the Assistant Vice President for Enrollment & Student Success, and the Assistant Vice President for Enrollment & Financial Aid on items that may impact enrollment.

Operating Procedures:

- The UPAC is contacted via the Vice Provost for Undergraduate Academic Affairs, Dept. Chair and/or faculty wishing to form a pathway or articulation agreement.
- Pathway and articulation agreement drafts are completed and reviewed by the appropriate parties for approval (Academic Affairs, Dept. Chair and/or faculty).

Relationship to Other Committees:

- The UPAC has a direct relationship to Transfer Action Teams (committees designed to develop goals and objectives for various community colleges and their individual partnership with NKU, i.e., Gateway2NKU, CState2NKU, KCTCS2NKU and IvyTech2NK).
